










Newport Coast, California: Population Comparison


Population Change Since 2010




Total Daytime Population

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

Population Living in Family Households


This chart shows the percentage of an area's population that lives in a household with one or more individuals related by birth, marriage or adoption, compared with other geographies.


Female / Male Ratio

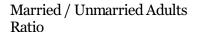








Newport Coast, California: Marital Status Comparison




Unemployment Rate


This chart shows the unemployment trend in an area, compared with other geographies.
